CIS will send out Employer Alliance newsletters quarterly reminding current employers and stakeholders of the resources we offer. We encourage recipients to forward Alliance emails to other people they know (friends, family members, neighbors, etc.) in the Delaware Valley who make or influence hiring decisions at their place of employment. **The power of the Alliance is in each of us spreading the word!**
