### Featuring Hy-Point Dairy Farms

Hy-Point Dairy was just a vision 90 years when John and Elizabeth Meany bought a farm in northern Delaware and started a dairy. Today, Charles Meany, owner and manager of Hy-Point Dairy, is the third generation of the family to run the business. Mr. Meany states, "Hy-Point Dairy has become our family tradition and we remain committed - as a dairy and as a family - to delivering the highest quality products to each and every one of our customers. Whether its our wholesome dairy products, our orchard fresh juices, or our old fashioned ice cream, we stand behind the Hy-Point seal.

Hiring people with disabilities to work at Hy-Point is also a tradition with the Meanys. Mr. Meany says he expects nothing less from workers with disabilities than all his employees. In March 2008, Mr. Meany hired Anthony Borreggine through CIS as a part-time receptionist and he has met and exceeded Mr. Meany's expectations. "Anthony is one of those people who wants to do a lot - and jumps at every opportunity to learn new tasks and take on more responsibility. And we hope to continue giving him more to do."

According to Gena Coley-Smith, CIS Job Coach, "Anthony is a quick learner who will figure out a way to get a job done regardless of his disability." Anthony, who is visually impaired, needs some accommodations to do his job. For example, he needs some work-related information converted to Braille. Gena helps Anthony arrange with Delaware's Division of the Visually Impaired (DVI) to Braille some documents. At one point, he needed to learn the new extensions and corresponding names of people he transfers calls to. DVI converted the new list to Braille, gave it to Anthony, and within four days he had the new list memorized.

Gena states, "Anthony is awesome and many times people do not realize that he is visually impaired because of his abilities and friendly disposition. Mr. Harold Schiffer - also known as "The Milk Man" - has made deliveries for Hy-Point for 28 years. Mr. Schiffer says "Anthony gets the job done and always has a smile for his coworkers. He makes working fun."

Mr. Meany is happy with Anthony's job performance and the support Hy-Point and Anthony receive from CIS. He recommends CIS to other employers as an agency that not only helps fill open positions, but provides support to those employees to help businesses thrive - and in the case of Hy-Point Dairy - to help carry on the family tradition.
